Request:

- Question 1. What is the email address of the person in your organisation who is responsible for the management of Subject Access Requests / DPA Requests?
- Answer: This is managed by the Information Governance team. The email address is <u>elft.accesstorecords@nhs.net</u>
- Question 2. What percentage of Subject Access Requests have been responded to on time since 25th May 2018? If you do not have this figure please provide a figure for what you do have.
- Answer: For the financial year 2018/2019, the percentage of subject access requests responded to on time was 93%.
- Question 3. On average how many SAR/DPA requests does your authority receive in a month?
- Answer: From August 2018 October 2019, the Trust has received an average of 112 requests per month.

Question 4. How many SAR officers are employed by your organisation who work on Subject Access Requests?

Answer: The Trust is unable to give an exact figure as a number of employees deal with subject access requests as part of their job description. To provide this information, we would need to contact each individual to determine how much time is spent on subject access requests.

Therefore, the Trust is unable to comply with this part of your request as the cost of compliance and extracting your exact requirements would exceed the appropriate cost limit of £450 which is specified in Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This is based on a rate of £25 per hour, regardless of the rate of pay of any individual involved in the retrieval of requested information, and equates to 18 hours work.

- Answer: The Trust has approximately 19 overdue subject access requests.
