

Supporting Someone with a Visual Impairment

TOP 10 TIPS

- 1. Ask the person what their level of visual impairment is and what support they need.
- 2. If they cannot see, let the person know when you have entered the room and when you are leaving.
- 3. If they are using a Guide Dog, approach from the opposite side to the dog.
- 4. Approach from the side with the best vision.
- 5. Tell the person what is around them.
- 6. When guiding, describe the surroundings. Use specific language; talk about colours, textures, shapes and landmarks.
- 7. When guiding into a chair place the person's hand on the back of the chair.
- 8. Support the person to use visual aids.
- 9. Provide information in larger print, audio format or Braille if beneficial.
- 10. Ask the person if they would like information by email.
