1.0 Purpose of the Report

1.1 To update the Council of Governors on the on-going elections 2017.

2.0 Election timetable

2.1 As announced at the July Council meeting, the 2017 Council of Governors Elections are being facilitated by the Electoral Reform Services (ERS). The election timetable is as follows:

3.1 Since the last election report in July, there have been additional seats available in Luton and Hackney due to recent resignations. As such the updated number of seats per constituency is provided below:

4.0 Statement of Nominated Candidates

- 4.1 The Statement of Nominated Candidates was issued by ERS on 13 September 2017 and it is attached to this report. A copy is being sent by ERS to all candidates and will be published on the Trust website.
- 4.2 The candidates in the constituencies of Hackney and Central Bedfordshire were elected uncontested as the number of candidates was equal to the number of available seats.
- 4.3 There were no nominations received in Luton and these seats will remain vacant until another election can be held.
