PATIENTS RIGHTS MONITORING FORM SECTION 132 OF THE MENTAL HEALTH ACT 1983

GUIDELINES

The patient should be informed of:

- The provisions of the act under which they are detained and the reasons for their detention
- The right to apply to the First Tier Tribunal and the right to free legal representation.
- The right to apply for a Hospital Managers review of detention.
- The information on consent to treatment and the right to be involved with the treatment plan.
- The role of the Care Quality Commission.
- The duty to give information to patients regarding their rights to an Independent Mental Health Advocate.
