

Masterclass:

An Evaluation of Palliative Care's response to the Covid Pandemic

Professor Higginson will be evaluating the response of palliative care to the Covid Pandemic. What lessons are there for us to learn - especially as pandemics are posited to be a more regular occurrence in the future.

Overview

Professor Higginson, OBE, is Executive Dean of the Florence Nightingale Faculty of Nursing, Midwifery & Palliative Care and Faculty Vice Dean (Research). She is also Director of the Cicely Saunders Institute at King's College London, the world's first purpose-built Institute of palliative care, integrating research, education, clinical services and support and information. She is an NIHR Senior Investigator (now Emeritus) and in 2013 was awarded Fellowship of the Academy of Medical Sciences for her contribution to the field.

Professor Higginson is Scientific Director for the charity Cicely Saunders International. She is currently very involved with symptom management; palliative and end-of-life care for COVID-19 patients.
