

North East London Behaviour Intensive Community Support Service (BICS)

A new service to support children, young people & their families to reduce behaviours of concern (BoC) & improve Quality of Life.

ABOUT THE SERVICE:

Positive Support Group (PSG) has partnered with NELFT and ELFT to develop and implement a service to support children and young people (CYP) with significant BoC, and those at risk of placement breakdown or admission to hospital under the Mental Health Act.

We will work with CYP, their families, and their network using a positive behaviour support (PBS) model to:

- Complete a Functional Behaviour Assessment, and implement a PBS plan to increase skills & decrease BoC
- Implement a crisis intervention for those CYP at immediate risk
- Provide training to families and networks

REFERRAL CRITERIA:

- CYP resides in a NEL borough
- CYP is under 18
- Significant concerns in the network, CYP is on or would meet criteria for the Dynamic Support Register
- The CYP has a diagnosis of ASD and/or LD or is on the waitlist and highly likely to receive this
- CYP already has professionals involved (e.g., social worker/CAMHS)
- Risk of placement breakdown or hospital admission
