(for children aged 6-12 years)



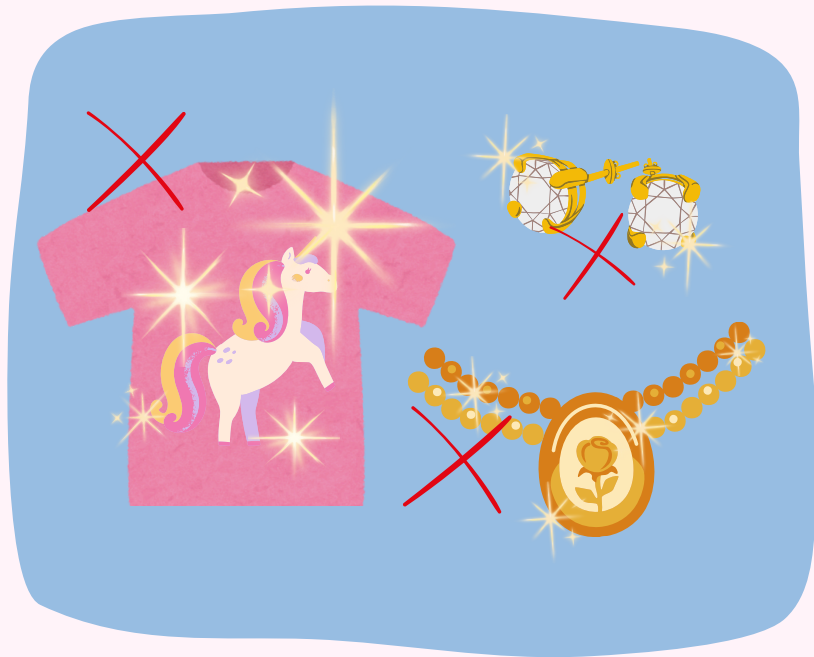

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Before I attend my Qb Test appointment at CAMHS, I will make sure I am not wearing jewellery or sparkly clothes.



When I arrive at CAMHS, I will let the friendly receptionist know my name.



I will meet with the friendly Qb Clinician in the Qb Room.

My parent will wait for me in Reception. I will leave my phone with them.



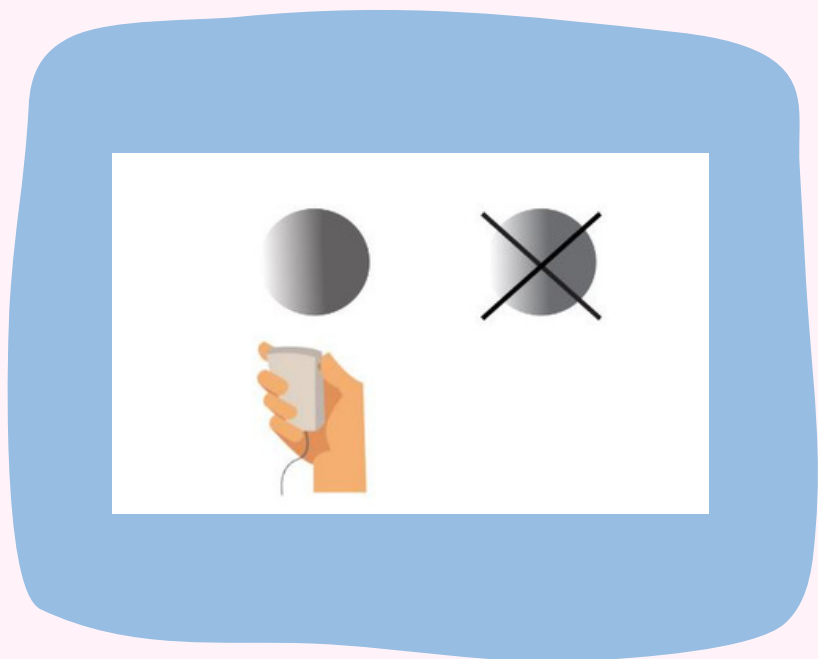
The Qb Clinician will explain the Qb Test and the instructions.

I will watch a short cartoon that explains the instructions too.



I can ask the Qb Clinician any questions I have about the Qb Test.

I will do some short, practice Qb Tests to make me feel comfy and ready for the main Qb Test.



The Qb Test involves pressing a clicker when I see a symbol appear on the screen.

**Headband
& reflective ball**



I will wear a headband during the Qb Test.

The headband has a reflective ball on it.

Sensor



The sensor in front of me will track the movement of the reflective ball.

The sensor will not record me.



When I do the Qb Test, the Qb Clinician will try and be quiet so that they don't disturb me. They might do some writing on a piece of paper.



The Qb Test is 15 minutes long.

I might make mistakes and that is okay. I will try my best. At the end of the Qb Test, I will get a certificate!
