

Accessing Training

This guide will talk you through accessing the eMHA training modules, hosted on the Learning academy and will include the NHS learning page once the training has been uploaded there.

Training via ELFT Learning Academy

1. Access the website on your trust laptop by clicking on the Left Learning Academy icon or by clicking on the link below



or

<u>https://learningacademy.elft.nhs.uk/login/learningacademy.php</u> (this link can be used on personal devices such as iPads and phones)

2. From the login page, Click on the Staff Login option





3. Enter you NHS.net details



4. Authenticate in your usual way (via text message or authentication app)
