It has been a monumental experience for all of the children and young people with DCD and their families to partake into this amazing journey and unleash their fullest potential in playing football with their peers.



The football coaches from Leyton Orient FC have received training from the Occupational Therapists on how to embed the Cognitive Orientation to daily Occupational Performance (CO-OP) approach into the football sessions which is the leading evidence based practice for children with DCD.

We have received positive feedback and learning experiences with the children and young people, families, staff and coaches throughout the duration of the football group sessions.

The football group is up and running again for its 2nd cohort of children and young people which started on 21st February 2024 and would be ending on 27th March 2024 at Langdon Park School.
