## Request:

Question 1: In the calendar year 2023 (1 Jan 2023-31 Dec 2023) please provide the total number of new diagnoses your trust has made for a personality disorder in a patient under 18 years of age.

'A personality disorder' includes both a general PD diagnosis, and a diagnosis of a subtype e.g. BPD, EUPD. I don't need to know the numbers of diagnoses of subtypes – please simply send the total number of new diagnoses.

Answer:

In the period 1 January 2023 – 31 December 2023, the Trust diagnosed a total of 14 patients who were aged 18 and under, with a personality disorder.
