## **Request:**

- Question 1: What is the current coding backlog?
- Answer: All coding is complete to the end of September.
- Question 2: How many Finished Consultant Episodes has the Trust coded in the previous 12 months?
- Answer: 6426 episodes were coded between 1st October 2023 30th September 2024.
- Question 3: When clinically coding a mental health inpatient discharge do you record codes for all of the following and if so, why?
  - Primary diagnosis
  - Secondary diagnosis
  - Any comorbidities
  - Injuries and/or overdoses
  - If not, which are omitted?
- Answer: All of the above are coded for every patient this is mandatory as per NHS England and Clinical Coding National Standards.

## Question 4: When clinically coding a mental health inpatient discharge do you code smoking status?

Answer: The discharge code to record smoking status is F17.1 and this must be coded for every patient who smokes - it is a National Standard, and it is mandatory to assign this code.
